IPMAT (IIM Indore) 2022:

IPMAT 2022 was conducted by IIM-Indore on July 2, 2022 for admissions into its five-year Integrated Programme in Management (IPM). To the surprise of everyone, exam was conducted with a revised structure with no prior information given to candidates.

The paper comprised 90 questions across three sections: Quantitative Ability (MCQ); Quantitative Ability (Short Answers), and Verbal Ability (MCQ). The duration of the exam was 120 minutes, with a sectional time limit of 40 minutes per section.

Every correct attempt would fetch 4 marks, while every incorrect attempt would attract a penalty of 1 mark (except for short answer section).

IPMAT Indore 2022: IPMAT Indore 2022 will be a 2-hour paper consisting of three sections Quantitative Ability (MCQ), Quantitative Ability (Short-Answer type) and Verbal Ability (MCQ). Each question carries 4 marks. For every incorrect answer, there will be a negative marking of 1 mark. The short-answer questions will not carry any negative marking.

IPMAT Indore Admit Card & Exam Day Guidelines

The IPMAT Admit card is necessary in order to take the exam, and for further admission process. IIM Indore's website has released the official admit card as of 11 June. Once the candidate has successfully registered for the exam, they can download the admit card, and preferably keep a hard copy ready to avoid any unwanted hindrances on exam day. Without it, the candidate may not be allowed inside the exam centre. A few things to keep in handy for the day are:

- Admit card
- Valid and original photo ID proof such as PAN Card, Aadhaar Card, Driving Licence, Passport, etc.
- Passport-size photo (preferably the one used in IPMAT Indore application form)
- Black/blue ballpoint pen
- Hand sanitiser
- Transparent water bottle
- Face mask
